**Garden Update:** The garden has been planted and we recently installed drip lines to water the raised beds. The garden faces east/west and gets thirsty with full sun all day long.

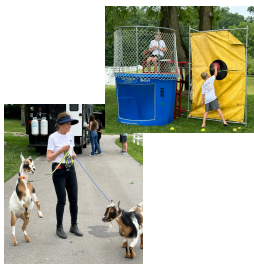
